- C.** Consider a Resolution authorizing and directing the City Manager or the City Manager's designee to execute any necessary documents for the purchase of an armored rescue vehicle through the United States General Services Administration and authorizing the City Manager to negotiate, finalize, and execute any and all agreements and other documents necessary between the City of Longview and Gregg County to provide for the County's participation in said purchase – Anthony Boone, Chief of Police.
