### ITEMS THAT CAN BE RECYCLED

- All plastic containers
- All metal cans
- All paper & cardboard

Residents must use City of Longview provided collection carts. Please rinse and drain plastic and metal cans; crush and break down boxes to conserve space.

- Glass\*
- Yard waste\*
- Mylar
- All food waste
- All liquids

## Yard Waste SERVICE

**W**e see a lot of yard waste here in East Texas. In order to divert as much as we can from the landfill, we offer a yard waste collection service at no additional charge. We ask that leaves, needles, brush and twigs be placed curbside in paper bags or loose in personal containers marked "yard waste." This separated yard waste will be taken to the City Compost Site at 2020 Swinging Bridge Road in Longview to be turned into mulch and compost.
